The Faculty of Engineering at Khon Kaen University (KKU) warmly invites students from around the world to join our vibrant academic community. Engineering, Khon Kaen University Exchange Program (ENKKUEx) offers international students an enriching and immersive experience, fostering engagement with academic courses and dynamic campus life. Participants will enjoy a supportive environment that promotes learning, cultural exchange, and personal growth.

As part of the program, visiting students participate in classroom activities without formally registering for courses or earning academic credits toward a degree. The program lasts for eight weeks but can extend to a full semester, depending on institutional agreements and individual availability.

There are no tuition fees for students. The Faculty of Engineering at KKU also provides complimentary accommodation during their stay.

ELIGIBILITY

- 1. Students must be officially nominated by ENKKU's partner universities.
- 2. Students in Engineering and related fields
- 3. A fair command of written and spoken English is required.
- 4. Students must cover personal expenses such as flights, meals, and other living costs during the program.
- 5. Students must be in good health.
