ACADEMIC PROGRAME

English is a global language that opens doors to education, careers, and cultural understanding. This programme will help you strengthen your functional English skills while gaining deeper insights into British culture. Lessons and workshops with experienced tutors are complemented by visits and excursions across York and Yorkshire, ensuring that learning is practical, engaging, and meaningful. Dedicated sessions on intercultural communication will prepare you to interact confidently across cultures, while a video research project will enhance digital literacy and provide valuable preparation for success in the modern, global workplace.





Programme aims

The aim of this programme is to develop your English language and intercultural communication skills. In particular it helps you:

- Strengthen your English language skills, with a focus on communication and functional language.
- Provide an in-depth understanding of British culture through immersive experiences and visits.
- Develop intercultural awareness and effective digital skills.
- Build academic skills such as seminar participation, presentation delivery, and reflective practice through a creative video project.

English Language and Culture

The main components of the summer school combine academic study with real-world experiences. Students will build their language confidence through interactive classes while also exploring British culture first-hand through cultural activities and excursions. This balance of classroom learning and experiential opportunities ensures that participants not only develop their English proficiency but also gain fresh perspectives on life and study in the UK.





Complementary Skills Sessions

To support language learning, students also take part in tailored workshops designed to develop key skills for higher education and international careers. Sessions include **intercultural communication** and academic skills workshops which equip participants to perform at a high academic level while preparing them for life and work in an increasingly interconnected world.

Course assignments and certificate

Students will complete two assessed elements:

- A personal learning log to track and reflect on progress.
- A video research project to apply skills in a practical, creative way.

Upon successful completion, participants receive a **University of York Certificate of Completion**, recognising their achievements and providing a valuable addition to their academic portfolio. Students who have completed the course will qualify for a 10% graduate tuition-fee discount at the University of York.

COLLECTIVE POWER.

Eligibility

This international programme is open to all learners aged 18+ that meet our entry requirements below.

You must have had your 18th birthday before the programme starts.

Academic requirements

Our summer school has no formal academic requirements, but we expect you to have a clear motivation for applying and enthusiasm for the subject. You will be asked to demonstrate your interest in your application.

English requirements

The programme is suitable for students who have been or are learning English as a second/foreign language.

We do not ask for proof of your English language proficiency, however to ensure all students receive the full value of the programme, applicants should have an intermediate level of English (at least around CEFR B1 or IELTS 4.5)

Accommodation

If you decide to book accommodation with us, you will be staying in a single room in one of 11 colleges situated on our wonderful parkland campus. Your fellow students will be staying in the same accommodation block, but you'll be able to have privacy in your own room. Rooms have shared bathrooms (the average room:bathroom ratio is 5:1).

Each accommodation block has a shared kitchen and you will be provided with basic kitchen equipment on arrival. There is a small supermarket on campus as well as a variety of food outlets and cafés.

Welfare and security

York is the 2nd safest city in the UK according to industry body Get Licensed in their 2023 review.

If you need any support, guidance or assistance during your time here our friendly Summer School team are here to help and our Campus Safety team provides emergency support 24/7.

Programme fees

Apply before 31st of March to take advantage of our early bird discount with a tuition fee of £1,800.

For applications received after this date the tuition fee is £1,920.

The tuition fee includes all tuition and course materials, transport and entry fees for timetabled trips and visits, a welcome dinner, optional free time activities*, Wi-Fi on campus and in York city centre and a certificate of completion.

Accommodation is optional and has a fee of £550 which includes accommodation for 14 nights in a single room on campus.

*some activities may have an additional cost which will be communicated on arrival.
